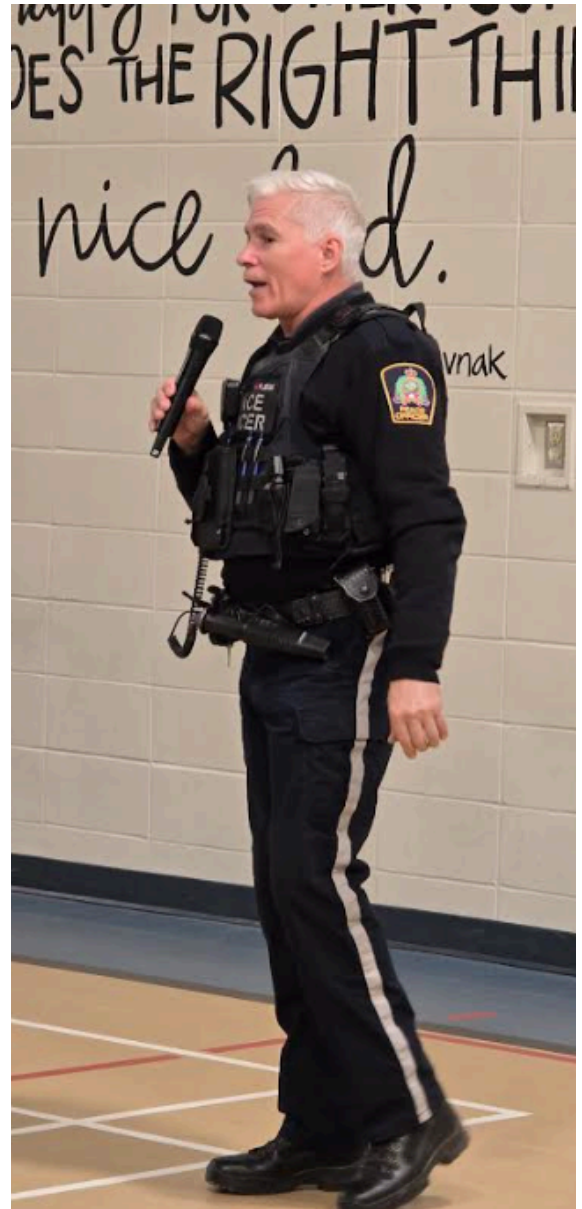

CES Fox Pup Update: We would like to inform our CES families and community that a young fox pup is currently living under our large storage shed on school grounds.

Alberta Fish and Wildlife has been consulted and advised that the pup is not considered a threat and is nearly old enough to leave the area on its own.

To help ensure safety and provide space for the animal, BGSD Maintenance will be installing a temporary snow fence around the shed area.

Our students have been informed about the fox and reminded to give it space and avoid the area near the shed. CES students have done an outstanding job respecting the animal and following these expectations. Thank you, students, for your maturity and cooperation.

We also ask for the support of our greater community in helping us give the fox pup the space it needs during this temporary situation. Thank you for your continued support and understanding.

This is a friendly reminder about our **Early Intervention Pre-Kindergarten / Preschool program**, and that we are **accepting requests for free development screenings until June 26, 2026**.



We will close our intake process for the summer and open it again for the fall. If you would like your child to have a spot early in September, please request a screening before June 26.

Who is the program for?

Every child grows differently. When little learners need a little more - we're here!

- Children must be 3 years old by December 31, 2026
- We also offer support to preschool children who are learning English as an additional language.

Children will experience hands-on learning in a happy, supportive environment. We are able to offer small class sizes and individually tailored plans for each child. Give your child the opportunity to build confidence and readiness for kindergarten.

Please keep in mind, other than a small fee for materials, which is waived for low-income families, **this program is free!** Also, our programs align with the regular school year calendar.

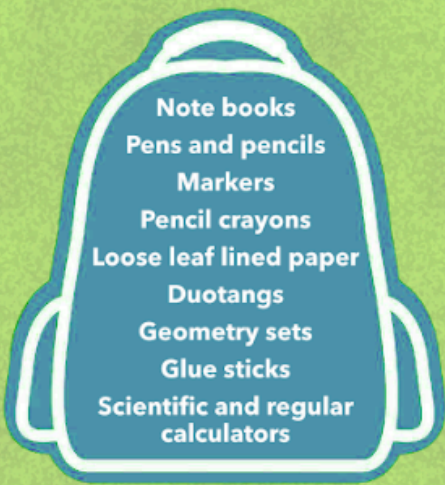
