Message from the Principal

As we move into the second half of the school year, Calmar Elementary will be placing an increased focus on literacy instruction to further support student learning and success. This focus is informed by our ongoing assessment data and our commitment to ensuring every student receives the support they need to thrive.

I am pleased to share some very positive staffing updates that will strengthen our ability to provide targeted literacy support. We have been able to hire additional teaching staff, which will allow us to make several important improvements. The new staff members will assume responsibility for the Physical Education program, freeing classroom teachers to work with students in small-group literacy and numeracy interventions. In addition, we are increasing our Learning Support Teacher (LST) time and restoring Mrs. Hodge's counselling time, ensuring students receive appropriate academic and social-emotional support.

Research consistently shows that small-group instruction is one of the most effective ways to support student learning, particularly in literacy. Targeted small-group interventions allow teachers to provide focused instruction, immediate feedback, and individualized support, all of which contribute to improved student outcomes.

Teachers will also be receiving additional professional development to ensure these supports are delivered effectively and consistently. Small-group placements will be determined using our literacy screening data and, where appropriate, additional diagnostic information.

These small-group interventions will begin on February 10, allowing staff time to prepare and participate in professional learning.

This is exciting news for our school community, and I am confident these changes will have a positive impact on student learning for the remainder of the year.
