Message from the Principal

ASSEMBLY UPDATE

I am pleased to introduce **Lisa Furler**, our **Family School Liaison (FSL)** with Black Gold School Division. Family School Liaisons are mental health professionals who work to strengthen partnerships between home, school, and community within BGSD schools. As part of our Student Services team, Lisa works closely with our staff and community partners to support students' educational and social-emotional development. Lisa is at Calmar Elementary two days each week and is supporting our **weekly Tuesday Character Education assemblies**, where she helps students develop important skills such as self-regulation, problem-solving, self-confidence, social skills, and strategies for managing stress and anxiety.

This month, Lisa is leading our Tuesday assemblies with a focus on **Social Emotional Learning (SEL)**. SEL is centered on five core competencies: self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship skills, and responsible decision-making. Research consistently shows that when schools prioritize SEL, students benefit academically, socially, and emotionally, while also building the skills needed for positive relationships and overall well-being.

This week, students began learning about emotions and healthy ways to cope with feelings that can be challenging. In the weeks ahead, our assemblies will continue to focus on empathy, friendship skills, and responsible decision-making. I am very pleased to have Lisa supporting this important work at Calmar Elementary and look forward to the positive impact these lessons will continue to have on our students.


