## Chocolate Chip Cookie Recipe:

| $21 / 4$ cups all-purpose flour $(550 \mathrm{~mL})$ | 1 tsp baking soda $(5 \mathrm{~mL})$ |
| :--- | :---: |
| $1 / 2 \mathrm{tsp}$ salt $(2 \mathrm{~mL})$ | 1 cup butter $(250 \mathrm{~mL})$ |
| $3 / 4$ cup granulated sugar $(175 \mathrm{~mL})$ | $3 / 4$ cup light brown sugar $(175 \mathrm{~mL})$ |
| 1 tsp vanilla extract $(5 \mathrm{~mL})$ | 2 eggs |
| 2 cups Chocolate Chips $(500 \mathrm{~mL})$ |  |

Options: May add 1 cup nuts ( 250 mL ). May add $1 / 3$ cup Cocoa.
May use dark chocolate chips, semi-sweet chocolate chips, milk chocolate chips, skor bits, peanut chips, etc.
Directions

1. Heat oven to $375^{\circ} \mathrm{F}\left(190^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\right)$.
2. Stir together flour, baking soda and salt. Beat butter, granulated sugar, brown sugar and vanilla in large bowl with mixer until creamy. Add eggs; beat well. Gradually add flour mixture, beating well. Stir in chocolate chips and nuts, if desired. Drop by rounded teaspoons onto ungreased cookie sheet.
3. Bake 8 to 10 minutes or until lightly browned. Cool slightly; remove from cookie sheet to wire rack. Cool completely. Makes about 5 dozen cookies.
