Note from the Principal

Reconciliation in Alberta, as well as across Canada, is a critical process aimed at addressing the historical and ongoing impacts of colonization on Indigenous communities. It involves acknowledging the injustices faced by Indigenous peoples, such as the legacy of residential schools, and working toward building respectful relationships, restoring rights, and ensuring equitable access to resources and opportunities.

Orange Shirt Day, observed annually on September 30, plays a significant role in this reconciliation process. It was established to honor the experiences of residential school survivors and to promote awareness of the harmful effects these institutions had on Indigenous children and their families. The day serves as a reminder of the importance of listening to Indigenous voices and understanding their histories.

In Alberta, where there is a rich diversity of Indigenous cultures, recognizing days like Orange Shirt Day fosters community dialogue, education, and healing. It encourages non-Indigenous Canadians to reflect on their roles in reconciliation and supports efforts to create a more just society. Celebrating this day helps to honor the resilience of Indigenous peoples and emphasizes the ongoing commitment to truth and reconciliation in addressing past wrongs and building a brighter future together.

- Google Classroom Update / that may affect you at home. A large majority of teachers leverage Google Classroom for student assignments. As a guardian, you can receive email summaries of your student's work and progress, including missing work, upcoming work, and recent class activities. Starting in fall 2024 you can also get guardian preview capabilities to view their Classwork page through direct links in the email summary. Note that neither email summaries nor preview capabilities include grading, you'll need access PowerSchool to see that information. We plan to sync guardian emails with Google Classroom in early October. You may be receiving an email from Google asking you to sign up for these email notices.
